Dr. Corrigan Starts Board Appointment as At-Large Director

Alexandria, Va. (January 26, 2018) — Brian Corrigan, PhD, will begin a 3-year term in 2018 as At-Large Director on the American Society for Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics (ASCPT) Board of Directors.

Throughout his 20 years in industry, Dr. Corrigan has championed the principles of clinical pharmacology and pharmacometrics to improve therapeutics for pain and neurodegenerative disorders. He is currently the Global Head of Clinical Pharmacology at Pfizer.

Dr. Corrigan was President of the International Society of Pharmacometrics (ISoP) in 2016, Programming Chair for the ISoP 2013 meeting, and Editorial Advisory Board member for the organization's *Journal of Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics*. He also served as Treasurer of the Midwest Users Group for Population Approaches to Data Analysis and co-chaired the Modeling and Simulation Workgroup for the Coalition Against Major Diseases (CAMD).

For his work on Alzheimer's disease and dementia, Dr. Corrigan was presented with the CAMD–Critical Path Institute Annual Recognition Award in 2010. He won the Medicines Development Group's Top Publication Award the same year.

Dr. Corrigan received his PhD in pharmacokinetics from the University of Alberta, Canada. He has mentored doctoral and postdoctoral students on the role of pharmacometrics in developing treatments for Alzheimer's and other neurodegenerative diseases.
