David Mitchell Is ASCPT's President-Elect

Dr. Mitchell has been an active member of ASCPT since 1997, serving on the Board of Directors and the Finance, Nominating, Webinar, and Education Committees.

Dr. Mitchell is Chief Scientific Officer at Nuventra Pharma Sciences. Before he started consulting in 2009, Dr. Mitchell led project planning and oversight at Array Biopharma. He has also directed development teams and clinical pharmacology teams for products in neuroscience, bone disease, and oncology at Pfizer, Procter & Gamble, and OSI Pharmaceuticals.

As a consultant for the pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries, Dr. Mitchell has helped many companies bring new drugs to market. He has more than 25 years of experience in clinical pharmacology and project leadership, as well as extensive expertise in pharmacokinetics, pharmacodynamics, drug metabolism, and modeling and simulation.

Dr. Mitchell earned his PhD in pharmaceutical sciences from the University of Colorado. He completed a postdoctoral fellowship in the Department of Pharmacology, Toxicology, and Therapeutics at the University of Kansas School of Medicine.

In addition to his multiple roles as a volunteer leader for ASCPT, Dr. Mitchell has participated on various councils and committees for the American Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists (AAPS), including as a Member-at-Large on the Executive Council and Chair of the Annual Meeting. In 2012, he served as President of AAPS.
