### ASCPT Will Present Pharmacometrics Award to Dr. France Mentré at Annual Meeting

**Alexandria, Va. (November 27, 2017)** — France Mentré, Ph.D., M.D., will receive the Sheiner–Beal Pharmacometrics Award at the 2018 Annual Meeting of the American Society for Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics (ASCPT), March 21–24, in Orlando, Florida.

Dr. Mentré is a Professor of Biostatistics at the Paris Diderot University School of Medicine (France) and leads the Biostatistics Department at Bichat Hospital in Paris. She is also Director of the team “Biostatistical Modelling, Clinical Investigations and Pharmacometrics in Infectious Diseases” for the French National Institute of Health and Medical Research (INSERM), a public scientific and technological institute that focuses on human health.

For more than 30 years, Dr. Mentré has worked to develop and apply statistical methods for nonlinear mixed-effects models and enhance understanding of varying responses to anti-infective agents. She is leading development of the software PFIM for optimal design in pharmacometrics.

“I am very honored, proud, and pleased to receive the Sheiner–Beal Pharmacometrics Award,” said Dr. Mentré. “Lew Sheiner was my mentor, and he really created the discipline of pharmacometrics. Along with my prestigious colleagues who have received this award in the past, I hope to preserve his legacy in my research and work.”

Dr. Mentré is an active member of several science-based organizations. She chaired the Executive Committee for the World Conference on Pharmacometrics and served on the Scientific Committee for the Population Approach Group in Europe for 10 years. She is also a member of the Statistics and Pharmacometrics Group for the American Statistical Association and International Society of Pharmacometrics (ISoP) and directs ISoP’s Model Evaluation in Pharmacometrics initiative. She is an Associate Editor for *CPT: Pharmacometrics & Systems Pharmacology*.

In 2013, Dr. Mentré received the Lewis Sheiner ISoP/University of California, San Francisco, Lecturer Award. She received the Honorary Fellowship Award from the American College of Clinical Pharmacology in 2016.
