Dr. Lam is Professor of Pharmacology at University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. He is also the James O. Burke Endowed Centennial Fellow in Pharmacy at University of Texas at Austin. Dr. Lam received his BPharm from University of Bradford, England, and PharmD from University of Minnesota.

Francis Lam's postdoctoral training included a Residency in Cardiology and Pharmacokinetics at University of Minnesota and a Fellowship in Clinical Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics at University of California, San Francisco. He is an elected Fellow of the American College of Clinical Pharmacy and Councilor of the Pacific Rim Association of Clinical Pharmacogenetics. Dr. Lam serves on the editorial board of Current Pharmacogenomics and Personalized Medicine, and is the lead editor of the textbook Pharmacogenomics: Challenges and Opportunities in Therapeutic Implementation. He had authored 69 manuscripts and 22 book chapters, most of them related to ethnic and genetic differences in drug disposition, as well as pharmacogenomic education and implementation.
